300-500 words

What honors, awards or recognitions have you received? List those achievements specifically related to your category first. If the title of the honor, award or recognition does not describe the achievement, please provide a brief description.

List the community service projects or activities in which you have participated that have benefited your community. Include the date range and the number of hours you spent on each project.

Describe what you consider the single most important project or activity in which you have participated that has benefited your community.

100-250 words

Write a short essay explaining your career goals, what you plan to study and why you want to further your education. Also explain how you plan to fund your college education.

100-200 words
