Summary of this Policy:

The Citizen Inclusion Act enables Voopmont citizens to write Petitions for government change.

I. Petitions

- A.** Citizens have the abilities to write Petitions for government change.
- B.** Citizens can sign petitions to help create that change.

II. Signatures

- A.** Citizens do not have to sign a petition.
- B.** If a petition writer attempts to force/bully someone into signing, the petition will be shot down.
- C.** In order for a petition to pass, it requires 6 signatures.

- D. Signatures must be confirmed before it is passed. Every false signature is a ¢500 fine.
- E. A false signature will cause a ban from making signatures for one month.
- F. If the petition still meets the requirements even without the false signatures, it still passes.

III. Petition Passing

- A. If a petition reaches the amount of signatures needed to pass, the change happens.
- B. The Council can not shoot down a petition, as it is what the people want.
- C. The Senator can shoot down a petition, but the Council can repeal it. Once repealed, the petition must pass.

IV. Boundaries

- A. Petitions must be constitutional. Any and all unconstitutional petitions will be shot down.
