


Introduction to Desmos (Getting Started)

This free graphing calculator allows students to create a free account to save all of their graphs, animations, and projects created.



Creating an account

Open google chrome and enter in the web address bar: <u>desmos.com</u> and click start graphing.



- 1. Click on Create Account (if you don't have an account) or sign in (if you have already registered for an account)
- 2. Click on Link to your google account
- 3. Use your google account to register.

Create and access saved graphs



To access saved graphs and create new graphs:

- 1. Click on the three parallel bars to open and close your saved graphs!
- 2. Click on "New Blank Graph" to create a new graph.
- Click on any saved project. Then click on the "Open Graph".

Settings of a graph







Saving a graph




- 1. Click on "Untitled Graph" name
- 2. Type name of your graph in the Title box
- 3. Click on "Save"

Sharing a graph



- 1. Click on Share icon
 - Options:
- Copy the link and share in a document
- 3. Print or save an image of your graph


Adding Items - Graph



- Image from CPM Educational Program
 - 1. Click on the +- and select f(x) expression
 - 2. Type in function. You may use the on-screen keyboard to access, click the bottom left keyboard icon to select.
 - 3. To change the color of the graph clicking the BLUE circle. Hold 3 seconds for the color palette to show. Select a different color.
 - 4. Save your graph

Adding Items - Note

- 1. Click on the and select
- 2. Type on your note
- 3. Save your work.



Keyboard Shortcuts

My Graphs: ctrl + o

Save: ctrl + s

Save-As or Rename: ctrl + shift + s

Undo: ctrl + z

Redo: ctrl + y

New expression: Press "enter"

Move up/down: Press the † and ↓ arrow keys

Move left/right: Press the ← and → arrow keys

Add a new text box: Press the quotation keys ("")

Delete an expression: Press "delete"

Symbols

∑ : Type "sum"

π: Type "pi"

θ : Type "theta"

√ : Type "sqrt"

☐: Type "prod"
