Sponsor Tracks

1. Problem Statement: Draft a 2-page problem statement on a problem with specifications for a policy-based solution. The Policython team will help advise.
2. Educational Resources: Provide links to enough educational resources to get policython competitors started.
3. Office Hours: Provide at least three hours of mentoring to teams assigned to the track on Friday or Saturday.
4. Judging: Provide the policython team with an estimate of time or number of briefs judged, as well as agree on a judging system, on Sunday between 11am and 4pm ET before 8/18 11:59PM ET, and then commit to judging all the submissions for the track.
5. Prize: Allocate a prize for the track winner. Multiple winners may be selected. Prize value should be around \$50-100. Recognition, and continuing to work with the winner after the policython, is the important part.
