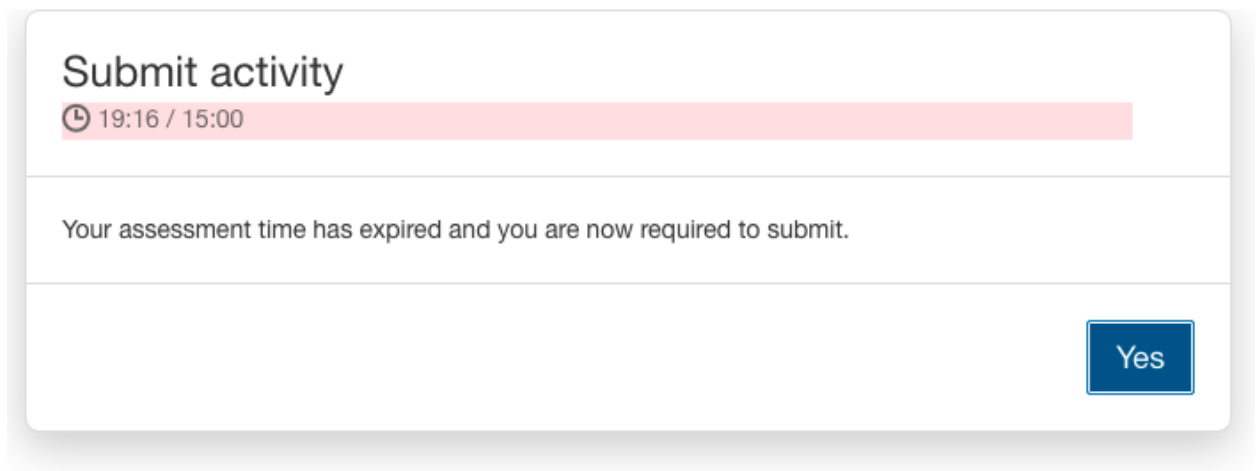


Notes about Timed Assessments

1. If a student exits the test WITHOUT submitting, the answers save.
2. If a student Submits the test the student can't go back into the test.
3. If a student does a second attempt, the student starts over at the beginning of the test.
4. If a student lets the time limit run out and then just clicks out of the browser, they can click back in and resume their test, and their time starts over.
5. If a student lets the time limit run out, and then clicks YES, they will not be able to resume.



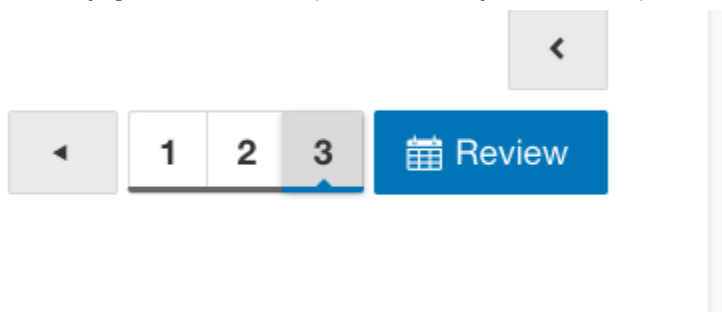
If they don't click Yes and just close out of the browser, they will be able to resume.

Notes about What the Student Sees

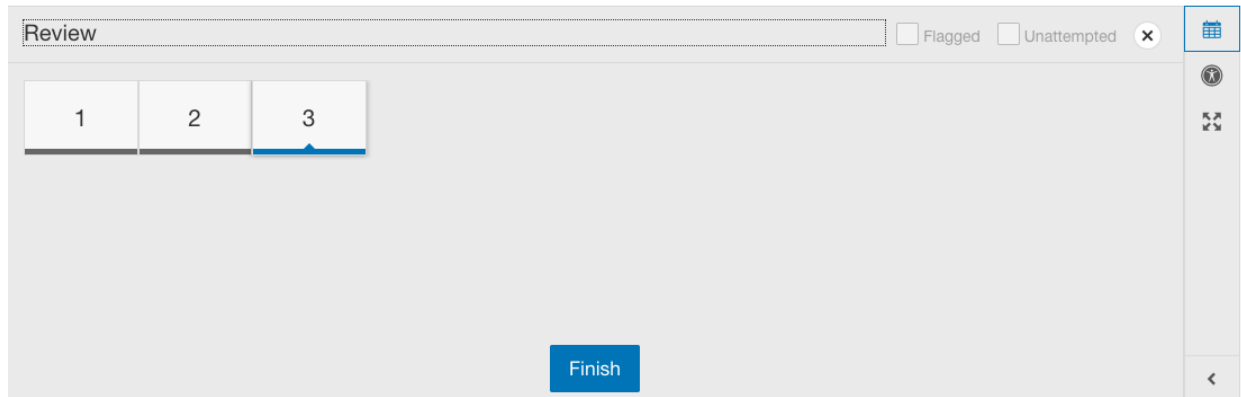
On the top right part of the assessment, there is a clock (as shown below).

When they get to the last question, they have an option to click "Review."



From there, they can click “Finish.” Once they click the finish button, they cannot come back to that attempt.



If they want to exit the test without finishing, they can just close the tab. When they do that and then go back to the assessment, they will see this:

When I clicked back in, it held the time for me (I was on 2:03, and it picked up right there). However, it doesn't seem like that always happens. It appears that if they quit the browser completely, the timer starts over.
