### ***Frequently Asked Questions:*** (\*\*Updated 4/17/2020\*\*)

**1. What do we do with LEARNER PROFILES?**

- a. Short answer: Hold on submitting them. As with all our processes, we are analyzing their effectiveness and how we can more easily (for all of us) compile the information. More to come.

**2. How are our kids going to pick their “electives” for next year?**

- a. This is another process we are working on. Like the learner profiles, hang tight...more to come!

**3. What are we going to do to prepare for the transition to RPI from Central/RPEL/Twin Lake?**

- a. Normally, we would have students visit RPI so that they can get the lay of the land. Our current thinking is that we will host something over the summer to give all parents/students time to come to the building and become acquainted with the layout. More information will be available in May.

**4. What are we going to do to prepare for the transition from 6th grade to RPMS?**

- a. We are currently working on this too. We anticipate having information in May.

**5. What do I do if my student has personal belongings in their locker?**

- a. During the Stay Home. Stay Safe order, students and parents are NOT allowed in school buildings. Therefore, we cannot allow you to come in to clean out lockers. Once the order is lifted, we will begin to make plans for a locker cleanout.

**6. What do I do if I have prescription medication in the office?**

- a. This will be handled on a case by case basis. Please contact Mr. Panozzo if you are in need of your medications.

**7. How can I order a yearbook?**
