Delete Office

- Click the **Change/Delete Office** tab

- Click the **Edit Office** button.

This will present a dialog where various parameters for the office will be presented.

- Change the Incumbents.

Notice this will automatically change all the position parameters, which is normally the case. If there is a reason why only one of the parameters need to be changed, uncheck the  **Synchronize the five values above** checkbox. This is extremely rare.
