GRAM, GRAPH: letter, writing, to write Greek: GRAMMA (letter, writing) GRAPHEIN (to write)

*Diagram (v): to draw a detailed picture of; to map out dia = across, out dia + graphein = to write out

*Program (v): to train; to teach

pro = forward (forth)

pro + gramma = to write forward

*Biographical (adj.): describing one's life bios = life bios + graphein = to write about the life of

SCRIPT, SCRIB: to write

Latin: SCRIBERE, SCRIPTUM

*Descriptive (adj.): giving details about; illustrating; explaining de = down de + scriptum = written down

*Subscribe (v): to believe in; to feel approval or agreement sub = under sub + scribere = to write under

*Manuscript (n): a handwritten document manus = hand manus + scriptum = handwritten
