Reports

President's Report – H.Z.

Principal's Report – Mr. Burns

- **Reading Olympics:** Teams have started to meet after school and are working through their list of assigned books and getting ready for the competition.
- The competition will be held on March 11th at 5:30pm at the Souderton High School.
- **MAP Assessments:** Coming up soon. These assessments are used to see what students are individually ready to learn.
- **Blue Crew Awards:** These awards have been a hit with students and they are loving the blue star swag tag for the award. We recently added a red apple

swag tag for positive cafeteria manners and behavior and also looking for academic swag tags and Bus swag tags.

- **New Houghton Mifflin Harcourt (HMH) Reading Curriculum:** This will be new for next year, with teachers piloting this new program in K, 2nd and 4th grade at Salford Hills and 1, 3 and 5 at other buildings in the district. The curriculum will be in place next year and will offer a great structured approach to teaching reading skills with interventions that are available in and out of the classroom for students who require more or those who require extra teaching.

Holiday Shop – C.C.

- The holiday shop took place on December 5th and 6th and was another huge success.
- The vendor decreased our qty of items based on last year's sales which led to us selling out of many items on Day 1. We successfully implemented IOUs and got all children the items they wanted prior to the holiday closure.
- We will be sending out a survey to all volunteers this week asking for feedback to improve on the Holiday Shop for next year.
- We have booked with the company again for next year which provides us with a box of prizes that can be used for Bingo - we will make sure the Bingo Committee gets that box of items when it arrives.
