 - Lower than 90% participation impacts district accreditation

 - Middle school #1 in state for math growth
 - District Unified Improvement Plan - Students below grade level on state assessment aren't making enough growth to get on grade level
 - Large influx of English language learners
 - No boundary changes this year
 - District wide cell phone policy will be coming so it is more enforceable.

 - New superintendent worried about enrollment decreases and attracting teachers.
