Teacher Presentation – Jessica Carr

The speaker introduced herself and her role as a mental health support provider.

She highlighted her **role's** key aspects:

 Academic, Social, and Emotional Support: Ms. Carr supports students in their academic, social, and emotional growth..

Four Main Areas of Focus:

 Collaboration: Ms. Carr collaborates with teachers, administrators, staff, and families to provide social, personal, and academic support to students. They work together to address students' diverse needs.

- Counseling: Ms. Carr provides universal support for the entire school and one-on-one and small-group support for students needing extra assistance. She also handles emergency interventions for high-risk students.
- Building Trust and Relationships: Building trust and maintaining confidentiality are crucial for her role. She aims to establish safe and inclusive relationships with staff, students, and families.
- Coordination: Ms. Carr coordinates referrals and connects students and families with community support outside the school when needed.

Her working Schedule: She works part-time, primarily on Tuesday and Thursday mornings. Her work includes both junior high and elementary school counseling.

Referral Process

- Teachers, administrators, and staff can identify students in need of support.
- Teachers complete a referral form that is sent directly to Ms. Carr.

Counseling Activities & Questions

 A question was asked about the process for students to see the counselor. Ms. Carr clarified that students do not have to give a reason to their teacher but can provide one if they wish. Teachers send an email to request a meeting.

Introduction
