

2026 TREMPEALEAU COUNTY 4-H SUMMER HORSE CLINIC

WHAT: The Annual Summer Horse Clinic offers instruction by knowledgeable trainers covering assorted topics, such as English, Western pleasure, horsemanship/equitation, showmanship, horse safety, and much more! Learn from experience, new ideas and techniques, make new friends, and have FUN!

WHO: Open to any member of the Trempealeau County 4-H Horse Project and horse project members from surrounding counties. Registration deadline is May 1, 2026, there is a **\$25 late fee** for any payment & registration not received by May 1st. Horse Camp is limited to 40 youth; registration is not complete until payment has been made in full.

WHEN/WHERE: Friday, June 12th & Saturday, 13th at the county fairgrounds, in Galesville. You are welcome to arrive and camp on Thursday, June 11th. Stalls are on a first come basis – **STALLS MAY NOT BE RESERVED AHEAD OF TIME and no reserving for friends.**

COST: Payment must be sent with registration form:

- ✓ \$100 per camper, grades 3 – 13; (includes t-shirt and meals)
- ✓ Clovers, grades K – 2, who are future members: \$75 (includes t-shirt and meals)
- ✓ Include a SEPARATE CHECK - \$25 per stall for stall cleaning, to be returned at the end of camp once stalls have been checked by appointed stall checker

OPTIONAL FEES: Must be sent with registration form:

- ✓ **Camping Fees:** \$50 for electrical/water sites; \$25 for primitive
 - o Please make **SEPARATE CHECK** payable to **Trempealeau Co. Ag Society**
- ✓ \$25 for extra T-shirts
- ✓ \$30 for adult meals
- ✓ \$55 per day fee for daily camp participants

CAMP DISCOUNT: There is a \$20 discount for those Trempealeau County youth *participating both days of camp*, grades 3-13, who have turned in \$50 or more in sponsorships. Also, do not forget to request camp funding prior to camp from the Leaders' Board.

WHAT TO BRING: A complete list of items to bring will be provided, prior to camp.

REMINDERS:

- Horses must be manageable and in good health. Campers are required to follow 4-H policy rules and will be in their campers/tents by **10:30 PM**. No visitors will be allowed on the premises past **10:30 PM**!
- Monetary donations for meals are gladly accepted.
- Arm bands will be provided for all paid campers. Parents and other family members will be provided an armband with meal purchase.
- Parents are encouraged to camp and participate along with their children.
- **Anyone LEAVING** camp must sign out and sign back in upon return, and **MUST** have parent's permission or Leaders' permission.
- **An adult must accompany campers staying over. No youth will be allowed to stay alone. IF a member is 18, they are not allowed to be the "adult" staying with a younger member.**
- For safety, Helmets **MUST** be **worn at all times** when riding or driving, even after hours by anyone under age 19... **NO EXCEPTIONS**
