College Board Testing Day- October 12, 2022

On this date, 368 sophomores and juniors took the PSAT. One hundred twelve seniors took the SAT. In total, 481 students were tested. The tests take nearly five hours to administer and complete. Students not testing worked asynchronously from home. The Media Center and Cafeteria were available for students that needed to attend school and were not tested.
