RECRUITMENT CONCERT — 6th Grade Band — CSHS Auditorium — 4/19/24

• Arrival

- If you ride a bus to school, you will ride your bus all the way to the high school. Do not get off at the middle school.
- If you get a ride to school, be sure to be dropped off at the high school
- When you arrive at the high school. Proceed to the band room. Directors and/or high school band members will be on hand to guide you.
- Breakfast is available for those who eat school breakfast. Stop by the cafeteria to pick up your breakfast, then proceed to the band room to eat. Remember your ID card or number for breakfast.
