Documents for Teen Drivers Required by the GA Dept. of Driver Services (DDS)

Plus Information for Students Who Took Driver's Ed at Newnan High

## REQUIRED CERTIFICATE OF ENROLLMENT AND ADAP

Students who plan to get his/her <u>Learner's Permit</u> or <u>Driver's License</u> need specific documents for the GA DDS. It will save you time and stress if you consult *their* website BEFORE you show up to their office.

The documents you need from Newnan High may include:

- 1. An "original" Certificate of Enrollment completed by the student's high school where the student is enrolled. This document is only good for 30 days!
- 2. An Alcohol & Drug Awareness Program (ADAP) Certificate which is provided to students who pass the ADAP test given in their Health & PE class (historically taught to 9th grade students at NHS.) If you did not take Health at Newnan High, or did not pass the ADAP test in that class, we can NOT issue an ADAP Certificate. If this pertains to you, you can take the FREE online eADAP course via the GA DDS. More details here.
- 3. Certificate of Completion of Driver's Ed course IF the student successfully completed this course, his/her teacher has given them a hard copy AND emailed a Certificate of Completion including 40 hours of driving time.

TO OBTAIN THESE DOCUMENTS FROM NEWNAN HIGH, you must complete THIS GOOGLE FORM with your CCSS school email account. Forms will be processed and delivered as follows: DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR, the Attendance Clerk will email students when the documents are ready to be picked up. If you have any questions during the school year, please contact our Attendance Clerk, Rosie Stewartson, 770-254-2880 ext. 818031. DURING THE SUMMER, our school hours are limited. You must still complete the GOOGLE FORM, and our registrar will let you know when the documents are ready for pick up.

Make sure you follow the guidelines posted by the DDS for any other documentation you may need.

You must contact the school where you took the Health & PE course.
