- Callbacks are planned to be held on September 20, 2022, and may be in person or virtual. Please carefully reference the show schedule below and let the director know about any conflicts you have on your "Season 15 A Christmas Carol Audition Form" under "Conflicts". See below for specific information regarding callbacks, casting, expectations, rehearsals, and the run of each show.
- The traditional rehearsal schedule throughout the season is usually weeknights 7:00 pm-10:30 pm and one weekend day rehearsal, except for Tech Week, which starts the week before opening and may require additional evening and weekend hours of rehearsal. NOTE: Directors do have the discretion to work on Saturdays or different times on Sundays as arranged with their casts. If you have any questions or concerns, please make a note of them on your audition form.



A Christmas Carol adapted by Greg Oliver Bodine Rehearsals will begin at the end of October. Performances are 3 consecutive weeks, Wednesdays thru Sundays, from December 1-18, 2022 at the Maverick Carter House.

Rehearsals are tentatively scheduled to begin at the end of October and will rehearse 6 days per week with some weekend rehearsals necessary. There may also be individual rehearsal times for scenes and monologue work as agreed upon by the director and actor(s). Rehearsals may be extended depending on the show's needs and the actors' availability. If you have questions or concerns, please ask. The show is set to run Wednesday-Sunday, tentatively, and currently includes two free student performances and at least one community talk back. You will be contacted if we would like to see you for callbacks.

Please note: There is a possibility that this production will be recorded for a radio broadcast.
