#### Update from Dr. Brown

- Thank you to all the parents and caregivers for coming to Back to School Night. There was great attendance.
- The teachers and I meet three times a year as a Data Cycle team. We look at all kinds of ways to quantify the students progression throughout the year for both academics and social and emotional support. The main focus is to ensure we make effective progress. The teachers will be sharing with you all on the progress made throughout the year.
- We have an open position in the school for an Educational Assistant providing inclusion support. College degree is required, please share if you know anyone that is interested in the position.
- On the front playground you will notice the beginning stages of the construction of our Outside Learning Lab, focusing on Sherborn sustainability, built with solar panels, roller lights, life sciences and rain water spickets. Julie Vitale has been leading the development of this project. This concept has been in the works for 3 to 4 years now. The initial fundraising goal for the project is \$40,000. The DS Education Fund was unfortunately not able to contribute this year. We will be looking to raise more money in the spring. This Learning Lab is just the beginning of the vision.
- Tomorrow is the 4th Annual Dover Arts Homecoming. This is made of 25 alumni visual artists and musicians. Our teachers have signed up to have them come into their classrooms and will be coming to All School Meetings. After that they will proceed to the other schools in the district. This is great exposure for the current students to see such talent by former students.

## **Enrichment Team Update** | Mary Lowder, Kristin Kohn, Raffaela Agostino

- ASM: Planning is underway! We have two scheduled, an acrobat on 10/21 and a Capoeira and Brazilian Music group on 1/20, and two more to go for the spring.
- K and 1st grade:
  - Kindergarten has one enrichment program scheduled with the Acton Discovery Museum in early April. We plan to add more programs in the near future, and will update everyone when we know more.
  - 1st grade has three enrichment programs scheduled for this school year! The students will be seeing author, Marty Kelley, on 4/4, Pumpernickel Puppets, on 1/24, and the Discovery Acton Museum on 3/9.
- 2nd and 3rd Grade:
  - 2nd-grade teachers shared the following enrichment programs they are interested in for the school year.
    - Author visit (either virtually or in person).
    - The New England Aquarium tide pool program with animals that the children can touch. Currently researching whether or not the program is running this year.
    - Museum of Science as a field trip. The enrichment team has researched and passed along the info to Stephanie Edleglass. Field trips are typically paid for by parents. There is an open question on funding for buses. Can this come from the enrichment budget?

- 3rd grade is meeting the week of October 5th to discuss enrichment programming for 2022-2023.
- 4th and 5th Grade:
- Lots of interest in bringing programming to the classroom.
  - 4th grade will be scheduling "Techsploration" in March or April again, an author visit, and a math or STEAM enrichment if the budget allows.
  - 5th grade has plans for an author visit from Gregory Mone, a visit from Paul Revere House, a visit from Royal House and Slave Quarters, and one from Theatre Espresso!

• The next program is being held at the high school on October 19th called *Minding your Mind* which talks about anxiety in students in school and how to mitigate and help navigate through these difficulties. There will be no virtual options, live only.

## PH Garden & Outdoor Classroom | Julie Vitale

- The Learning Lab is now up. It needs to be primed and painted. Katherine Head will be picking the color. The spring fundraiser funded the outdoor learning lab with solar panels, organization tools, gardening tools. We are currently working with the district and town on permits for occupancy, we are hoping for a spring time frame.
- The grade level enrichment projects Kindergarten is doing pumpkins and learning about the stages of growth. We are working on getting grow lamps for the 1st, 2nd and 4th grade to assist with their lessons on plants. The 4th graders are learning about flower dissection and birds. The 5th graders will be doing a Veggieville and determine what to do with the veggies, either donate to teachers, COA or food pantry.
