Studio Rules and Policies

Attendance

Attendance is an important part of dance classes. Absences affect you/your child, as well as, other members of the class. There are no refunds on missed classes. There will be make-up classes scheduled to accommodate weather related cancellations. Please notify the Director of ADAM and/or instructors if you/your child will be absent. In the event of an extended illness/injury or other unforeseen circumstances, please contact the Director as soon as possible. The Director and Instructors must be notified of any sports related absences during the first week of the session. In the event of three or more absences, you/your child may be pulled from part or the entirety of class pieces. Exceptions apply.*

Sports schedules must be turned in four months before the dance recital to be taken into consideration when scheduling the show. Please note that show dates may interfere with sports schedules.

Snow Cancellations

All Cancellations and/or Delays will be posted on the Studio ADAM Student & Parent Page and the ADAM Calendar. Make-up classes and additional rehearsals will also be posted.

Class Behavior & Etiquette

We want all of our students to have an enjoyable and educational dance experience. We will treat you and your children with courtesy and respect. We expect our students to show the same toward their teachers and fellow dancers.

We request that your children observe the following simple rules:

- Pay Attention to your teacher – Don't talk with your friends during class. It disrupts the whole class and makes it difficult for the teacher to communicate with the students.
- Do not pull on or hang from the Ballet Barres. They can be pulled from the wall or you can get stuck in them. This could result in potential injury.
- Come prepared to dance – Have proper dance attire, attitude, energy.

Students should arrive at the studio with sufficient time to change into dance shoes to begin class on time. If students need to leave before the end of the class, they should notify the teacher before class begins. Students may not leave the classroom without first receiving permission from the teacher.

Teachers have the responsibility to see that their class is under control, and they have the authority to dismiss any student who will not cooperate and is a disruption to the rest of the class. Inappropriate dress or behaviour will not be allowed.

No gum, food or drinks will be permitted inside the classrooms during class or rehearsal except for water. No street shoes may be worn in the studio at any time.

*Absences may be excused by the Director or class instructors in special circumstances.

Example: In cases of global pandemic, natural disaster, or family emergency.

Photo and Video: Consent is granted for the student to be photographed or recorded. These may be used by the Academy of Dance Arts and Movement without compensation.

Injury Release: It is understood that the risk of physical injury is inherent in dance training. The Academy of Dance Arts and Movement strives to reduce that risk through proper training techniques. However, by signing this form, the undersigned is willing to assume those risks and release, hold harmless, and indemnify from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, judgements which the undersigned, ever had, or may have against Academy of Dance Arts and Movement, for any losses, costs, and expenses (including attorney's fees) and damages or injuries known or unknown, real or personal, sustained by me or my child while in attendance and/or participating in all Academy of Dance Arts and Movement classes, programs, camps, and shows. The undersigned also agrees that they will not hold Academy of Dance Arts and Movement responsible for the loss or damage of personal property while in attendance and/or participating in any Academy of Dance Arts and Movement program.

Physical Contact: Dance is an art form that requires teachers to be able to have appropriate physical contact for the purpose of making technical corrections. Consent is granted for such physical contact.

Rules and Policies: The signature below implies agreement to abide by the rules and policies of the Academy of Dance Arts and Movement. This includes, but is not limited to, behavior that exhibits respect to fellow students and the teacher as well as the facility.
