

EMERGENCY RESOURCES

- ★ For non-emergency crime reports/prior incidents that DON'T need police **Call 311**
- ★ MN Poison Control – call to request immediate transportation **1-800-222-1222**
- ★ Emergency or high-risk situation **Call/Text 911**

Mental Health Crisis

- Community Outreach for Psychiatric Emergencies (COPE, separate from police) – talks to person over phone, may also send mobile unit **612-596-1223**
- Suicide and Crisis Lifeline **Call/Text 988**

Substance Abuse

- Red Door Clinic – Provides Narcan for opioid overdoses **612-543-5555**
