OSGA Resolution #SC25-009

AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution urging the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the Oklahoma State Government to require all public universities and colleges, and urge all private universities and colleges to limit the usage of Artificial Intelligence in grading and assessments for instructors.

WHEREAS, Artificial Intelligence, or “AI,” is not heavily regulated in the United States, nor is it heavily regulated in Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, according to Northern Illinois University, algorithmic bias could disadvantage students with different writing styles or cultural expressions; and

WHEREAS, while using AI to grade students works is considered time-saving, especially in larger institutions, students pay for the guidance of human professionals, not generative AI; and

WHEREAS, furthermore, students are often barred from using generative AI in their assignments and assessments; and

WHEREAS, according to Northern Illinois University, questions of data privacy and storage loom large for institutions collecting student work that students do not consent to.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION THAT:

1. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the Oklahoma State Government will review the current usage of Artificial Intelligence in grading and assessment by instructors and require all public universities and colleges, and urge all private universities and colleges to limit the usage of Artificial Intelligence in grading and assessment for instructors.
