





School Lunch

Children need healthy meals to learn. Juab School District offers healthy meals every school day. All breakfasts cost \$1.40; Elementary and Junior high lunch cost \$1.80; lunch at the high school is \$2.00. Your children may qualify for free meals or for reduced-price meals. The reduced price is \$.30 for breakfast and \$.40 for lunch.

Breakfast will be served at all District schools 20 minutes before the start of school. <u>Lunch Menus</u> are posted each month on the district website and each individual school website. Menus are subject to change without notice.

We encourage you to fill out a free and reduced lunch application if you haven't already. Please go to ezmealapp.com to apply today if you think you may qualify.

Parents May Apply for Fee Waivers

Parents who have children in secondary schools should be aware that their children may be eligible for a waiver of school fees. The law does not permit fees at all in grades 1 - 6. Further, the law indicates that a child in grades 7 - 12 likely would be eligible for fee waivers if the parent or guardian's income is at such a level that their child is eligible for free school lunch.

Parents who receive any state or federal assistance likewise may be eligible to receive fee waivers.

If a parent believes that their child might qualify for fee waivers, they should contact the child's school for the appropriate forms. Based on the information parents submit, school principals will determine, according to District and State guidelines, if in fact, the student is eligible for fee waivers. An appeal process is in place if a parent disagrees with the local school's decision.

Student Fee Policy, District Elementary Schools 2021-2022

There will be no fees at District elementary schools during the regular school day. Some donations may be requested for projects, field trips, or activities. No student is required to pay these donations to participate in activities. Special instructional activities outside of the regular school day (or school year) may be subject to fees.

Immunization Requirements Early Childhood Programs, Kindergarten, and 7th Grade Entry

Students entering a Utah school, kindergarten through 6th grade, must be fully vaccinated with the following immunizations. A student must have written proof of receiving the following immunizations:

- 5 DTaP (4 doses of DTaP, if 4th dose given on/after the 4th birthday)
- 4 Polio (3 doses, if 3rd dose was given on/after the 4th
- 2 Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 2 Hepatitis A
- 2 Varicella (chickenpox) If a student has a history of Chickenpox disease, the student must submit a document signed by a healthcare provider to the school as proof of immunity.

In addition to the immunizations required above, the following immunizations are required to attend 7th through 12th grade. A student must have written proof of receiving the following immunizations:

- 1 Tdap booster
- 1 Meningococcal

Proof of immunity to disease(s) can be accepted in place of vaccination only if a document from a health care provider stating the student previously contracted the disease is presented to the school.

For children whose parents claim an exemption to immunization for medical, religious, or personal reasons, their legally responsible individual must complete an online immunization education module at immunize.utah.gov. A copy of the certificate must be presented to the school or child care official.

For a medical exemption from the required immunizations, a completed vaccination exemption form and a written notice signed by a licensed healthcare provider must be presented to the school.

Bus Safety

Getting Ready for School

- Have your children put everything they carry in a backpack or school bag so that they won't drop things along the way.
- Encourage them to wear bright, contrasting colors so they will be more easily seen by drivers.
- Make sure children leave home on time so they can arrive at the bus stop before it is due, ideally at least five minutes early. Running after or in front of a bus is dangerous.

Walking to the Bus Stop

- Walk young children to the bus stop or encourage children to walk in groups. There is safety in numbers; groups are easier for drivers to see.
- Practice good pedestrian behavior: walk on the sidewalk, and if there is no sidewalk stay out of the street. If you must walk in the street, walk single file, face traffic, and stay as close to the edge of the road as you can.
- Stop and look left, right and then left again if you must cross the street. Do the same thing at driveways and alleys. Exaggerate your head turns and narrate your actions so your child knows you are looking left, right and left.

At the Bus Stop

- Have children wait in a location where the driver can see them while driving down the street. Try to avoid waiting in a house or car.
- Do not let children play in the street. Playing with balls or other toys that could roll into the street is also dangerous.

Getting On and Off the Bus

- Warn children that if they drop something getting on and off the bus, they should never pick it up. Instead, they should tell the driver and follow the driver's instructions.
- Remind children to look to the right before they step off the bus.
- If you meet your child at the bus stop after school, wait on the side where the child will be dropped off, not across the street. Children can be so excited to see you after school that they dash across the street and forget the safety rules.

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




