

Font Guide & Sample Pairings

Font Styles and Sizes

Unlike the academic papers we are trained to write in college, a resume is an opportunity to add some personal style and edge—in a tasteful way. Here are some tips on how to do that without going overboard.

Suggested Fonts:

- For a more classic look, use fonts like Book Antiqua, Garamond, Cambria, and Times New Roman
- Modern and stylized fonts include Arial, Arial Narrow, Trebuchet, Calibri, Tahoma, Helvetica, or Verdana

Other Font Tips:

- Using different fonts for header text and body text can be an eye-catching detail when done properly. Look up examples of font pairings to see which styles compliment one another.
- Fonts differ in their readability depending on size. Make sure your fonts are not too difficult to read on both the digital and print versions of your resume
- Not all font sizes are created equal! Look at these different font styles, all set to 11-point font:
 - This font is Arial
 - This font is Calibri
 - This font is Times New Roman
 - This font is Garamond

The recommended standard size for resume body text font is 11pt., but sometimes it is necessary to use other sizes based on which font you select. The table below shows suggested body text font sizes for several popular fonts:

Times New Roman	11
Book Antiqua	11
Cambria	11
Garamond	12
Arial	11 or 10
Trebuchet	11 or 10
Calibri	12
Tahoma	11
