In September of 1862, Anton Dreps and his wife Josephine bought an 80-acre farm that our restaurant and winery now stand on. The farm included a log cabin which Anton built his brick farmhouse upon. Members of the Dreps family continued to farm this land for over 100 years. In 1891, the farm expanded to include what is now Pine Hills Country Club. Like most farmers of the time, teams of horses were used to farm the land. There was one horse in particular that was a family favorite. The Percheron's name was Birdy – and Birdy is our Blind Horse. When owners Bob and Connie Moeller discovered this information in the Sheboygan County historical archives, they felt compelled to name the property 'The Blind Horse' after Birdy.
