Writing	<ol> <li>Write in your journal for about 25 minutes.</li> <li>Don't forget to edit your writing for capital letters, periods and known trick words.</li> <li>Share your writing with someone at home</li> </ol>
Reading	<ul> <li>Questioning - Nonfiction Books</li> <li>You will need one nonfiction book that you can read independently for this lesson.</li> <li>You can use a "post-it" to write your questions or a seperate piece of paper.</li> <li>1. Asking questions before, during and after reading nonfiction books is important, too!</li> <li>2. Watch video</li> <li>3. Now, take out your nonfiction book. Write one question you have before you read. Begin reading your book and stop during your reading to write another question. After you finish your book, write one more question about what you are still wondering. If you'd like, take a picture and send your questions to your teacher.</li> <li>4. Have a family member ask you some questions, too. Good readers can ask and answer questions about their reading.</li> </ul>
