- 2. develop entrepreneurial skills on basic sales and marketing.

MUJER includes series of trainings for the economically displaced women of Barangay Baliwasan, which is in line with the GAD mandate, to give opportunity for women in the barangay to learn additional skills that can be used for income generation and self-employment. MUJER is also anchored on ZCSPC Extension Agendum — Skills Capacitating/Competency Upgrade for Local and Overseas Employment (SCCULOE). The approach to be used is stewardship. The stewarding interventions of the community or Steward-Barangay strategic initiative will be focused on generating outcomes and impacts which necessarily must be changes in mindset, values system, capability to earn a living and civic consciousness. Engagements will be long-term where ZCSPC Extension's umbilical chord will remain in place until the aspired transformation has taken roots and gradually withdrawn as demand waned.

The research project on **Women's Mental Health and Economy: Coping and Responding during Pandemic** brought windows of actions to apply the principles of Gender and Development (GAD). The authors coming from the GAD Office, Research Facilitation Office (RFO), and Planning and Development Office (PDO) are submitting to you a few of the important research recommendations particularly on the response aspect of the research because of the COVID-19 Pandemic:

- Create community Inventory of women with vulnerable economic status such as those
 who were disenfranchised by their employers, income loses from the industries they are
 earning from, and what skills they are currently practicing and can learn. This will be use
 for decision making on how to mitigate their economic situations.
- 2. Develop an "economic path to success team" to aversee the economic profiles of affected women from different sectors or economic structures like schools, companies, and other industries. The task force on economic path to cope and respond can be specifically created to educational organizations or to the women in communities with both formal and informal economic settings. Schools can assist women in terms of training and becoming part of their Income generating offices.

A research and extension project: MUJER or Mobilizing and Upskilling JUANAs for Economic Resiliency is in the works to realize the recommendation of the study. A preliminary conversation and general information-gathering was commenced with the Barangay Chairperson of Baliwasan, Zamboanga City to arrange the conduct a survey among their selected women constituents who were economically impacted by the current crisis to dig deeper on their needs.

Memorandum of Agreement between ZCSPC and Baliwasan Barangay Council.

WHEREAS, BALIWASAN BARANGAY COUNCIL, has offered its constituents, who wish to be trained by ZCSPC Trainers/Instructors, a series of training in preparation for their sustainable livelihood.

WHEREAS, BALIWASAN BARANGAY COUNCIL, offers to provide a venue for the production and marketing area of the organized group of women in the barangay who are part of the Extension Program MUJER.

OBJECTIVES:

The Extension Program MUJER aims to:

- mobilize economically displaced women in Barangay Baliwasan for a livelihood training program; and
- 2. transfer knowledge, and competencies of healthy food production among economically displaced women of Barangay Baliwasan.

At the end of the Extension Program MUJER, the beneficiaries should be able to:

- 1. apply knowledge and financial literacy on their livelihood; and
- 2. develop entrepreneurial skills on basic sales and marketing.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and stipulation herein set forth, the parties consensually and reciprocally bound and agreed as they hereby bind and agree between themselves as follows:

- 1. **ZCSPC** shall be responsible in the screening and selection of trainees and shall enroll not less than 15 or more than 30 trainees per training course.
- 2. **ZCSPC** shall provide the training venue and amenities, like chairs, tables, potable water, electric power, etc., for the series of training.
- 3. **BALIWASAN BARANGAY COUNCIL** shall provide trainees transportation to and from the training venue;
- 4. **ZCSPC and BALIWASAN BARANGAY COUNCIL** shall finalize the preparations at least one(1) week before each extension activity under the Extension Program MUJER.
- ZCSPC shall not be liable for any claim/ damages arising from any act, omission or negligence of the trainee for any cause beyond ZCSPC control.
- 6. **ZCSPC** shall conduct series of training to the beneficiaries of Extension Program MUJER.
- BALIWASAN BARANGAY COUNCIL shall assist in all related activities pertaining to the implementation of ZCSPC Extension Program MUJER including evaluation of the program and monitoring of implementation.
- 8. This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect upon signing thereof, and the same shall be considered terminated upon mutual agreement by both parties.
