Watercolor Palette

A plastic pan or watercolor palette that has large wells for mixing color. Optional if you already have one you love. Speedball Robert E. Wood Covered Palette is one I like!

Neutral Tint

3 - 4 sheets of 300# cold press Fabriano 22 x 30 size watercolor paper.

Optional: 3 - 4 sheets of Arches 140# cold press. I do prefer the 300# Fabriano!

Optional Sketchbook: A small sketchbook is always good to have on hand. This is a recent favorite. I like that it has 140# watercolor paper that is perforated.

Daniel Smith 66 Dot Chart. I love this reference tool for sampling new colors before i purchase them. With the dot card, you will be able to try out almost any color in the line without buying a whole tube of paint! With a wet brush, the dried dots become brilliant, brushable watercolor. Each watercolor dot is labeled with essential color info (name, series, lightfastness, etc.) for easy reference. Available in 66 or 120 colors. Winsor and Newton also has a 109 color dot chart.
