Purpose

One of the main purposes of The THS Student Union is to ensure student influence in our education. This extends, of course, to the master programs as well. The Physics chapter is responsible for six master programs: Engineering Physics (TTFYM), Nuclear Energy Physics (TNEEM), Mathematics (TMAKM), Applied and Computational Mathematics (TTMAM), Computer Simulations for Science and Engineering (TDTNM or COSSE) and Biostatistics and Data Science (TBDVM). The student representatives in these programs are assigned by, and report to, the Physics chapter and represent all students in their program. This ensures representation for all students, and that their voices are heard by the faculty.

Mission tasks

The MAS will:

- **Have contact with the PA of the programme:**
Continuously be in contact with the PA (Program Director) of the program to discuss matters of Courses and Quality of Education, and to convey Student opinions. Discuss with the PA and any other MAS on your program how you want this contact to function.
- **Have contact with the Physics chapter study board:**
Inform the Physics chapter study board of current matters in education at least once per study period. You should include at least:
 - A status update on all compulsory courses on the program.
 - A summary of your contact with the program, for example the PA.
 - The general student opinion about the program.
- **Gather student opinion:**
Gather student opinion on courses and the general state of the program at least once per study period. This can be achieved either by a physical gathering of students where



the courses and the program as a whole are discussed or by sending a questionnaire to the students of the program where they can state their opinions.
