These are the terms & conditions for all League Trolli Tournaments. These rules are subject to change at the discretion of League Trolli Operators.

1 SUMMARY:

League Trolli is a grassroots esports league providing competition-filled fun for players in the United States and Canada. All online League Trolli tournaments are free to enter - check the description of each bracket for tournament-specific information.

2 DEFINITIONS:

- 2.1 "*Tournament Organizer*" or "*TO*" League Trolli works with organizations or individuals commonly referred to as tournament organizers or 'TOs'. These organizations or individuals are charged with operations on a tournament-level at the discretion of the program manager
- 2.2 "Twelve Thirty LLC" payment vendor for League Trolli
- 2.3 "Challonge LLC" program and operations manager for League Trolli Operations
- 2.4 "Bad-standing" a player will receive a status of bad-standing and potential exclusion from events when one of the rules in this document is violated resulting in a temporary suspension or ban

3 PLAYER RULES:

- 3.1 Eligibility:
 - All players in sanctioned League Trolli tournaments must be at least thirteen (13) years of age prior to registration. Minors, defined as players aged seventeen (17) and below must have parental or guardian consent to play in these events.
 - League Trolli is available only to residents located in the United States & Canada
 - All League Trolli Participants must abide by Section 4: "Code of Conduct" while participating in League Trolli-sanctioned events
 - Players will not be eligible to participate in League Trolli events if they enter into *bad-standing* as the result of a suspension or a ban from breaking any of the rules outlined in this document.

4 CODE OF CONDUCT

4.1 Respect for all players:

- Treat all players with respect, regardless of their skill level, background, or identity.
- Do not engage in any form of harassment, discrimination, or offensive language.
- Do not engage in any behavior that promotes hate speech, racism, sexism, or other forms of discrimination.

4.2 Fair Play:

- Play by the rules and adhere to the official game's terms of service.
- Do not cheat, exploit, or use unauthorized software to gain an unfair advantage.
- Report any suspected cheaters or rule violators to league administrators.

4.3 Good Sportsmanship:

- Be a good sport, win or lose gracefully.
- Avoid trash-talking or unsportsmanlike behavior towards opponents.
- Encourage friendly and positive interactions with other players.

4.4 Game Integrity:

- Do not engage in match-fixing or deliberately lose games to manipulate rankings.
- If you suspect any form of game manipulation, report it to league administrators.

4. 5 Privacy and Security:

- Protect your personal information and be cautious about sharing it online.
- Do not engage in doxxing or attempt to access other players' personal information.
- Respect the privacy and security of all participants.

4.6 Communications:

• Use respectful and appropriate language in all communication relative to League Trolli operations. This includes but is not limited to interactions with teammates, opponents, tournament organizers and league officials.

4.7 Reporting Violations

- If you witness or experience a violation of this code of conduct, report it to league administrators promptly.
- Provide clear evidence when reporting violations, if possible.

4.8 League Decisions:

 Accept the decisions and rulings of league administrators in cases of disputes or violations

4.9 Parental Consent for Minors:

- If you are under the age of eighteen (18), obtain parental consent to participate within League Trolli
- Ensure your parents or legal guardians are aware of your involvement in League Trolli.

4.10 Legal Compliance:

- Abide by all relevant laws and regulations in your jurisdiction.
- Do not engage in any illegal activities while participating in the league.

4.11 Code Updates

• This code of conduct may be updated from time to time. Keep yourself informed of any changes.

Failure to adhere to this code of conduct may result in warnings, temporary suspensions, or permanent bans from League Trolli events, depending on the severity and frequency of the violations at the sole discretion of League Trolli administrators.

By participating in League Trolli, you agree to abide by this code of conduct and uphold the values of fair play and sportsmanship.

5 PRIZE RULES:

5.1 Prize Eligibility & Guidelines

- In order to claim a prize, you must have: a) conformed to Section 3.1: 'Eligibility' requirements; b) finished within the accepted range of winners for that tournament; c) completed and then submitted the prize request form located in the tournament description.
- Prizing is only available for taxpayers located in the United States & Canada.
 - o For UNITED STATES participants, the ability to fill out and submit a W-9 tax form is required of any player participating in a League Trolli Tournament. If a player does not meet the criteria to submit this form, they are not eligible to participate nor receive prizes from League Trolli. Criteria necessary for submitting a W9 are but not limited to: Social Security Number & US mailing address
- League Trolli utilizes a payment vendor, *Twelve Thirty LLC*, to process all prize-related payments and collection of W-9 forms.
- If you earn \$600 or more, you will be contacted by Twelve Thirty LLC via your most recent 'best contact' email address that you submitted to the prize request form. Twelve Thirty LLC will provide instructions on submitting the proper tax

- information. Failure to provide a W-9 will result in a status of bad-standing, making you ineligible for further League Trolli events.
- In the case of a team-based tournament, prizes are awarded to each team member separately
 - An individual may use a teammates PayPal address if they a) do not have one and b) submit a prize request using their information with the only difference being the PayPal
 - If a prize totals \$600 USD or more, a unique, played-owned PayPal must be used. I.e. Jake35@gmail.com can't be used as the PayPal for more than 1 player.
- There is a 30-day window to claim prizes from the completion of the tournament. If a participant fails to submit the required information within 30 days, prizing is not obligated to be distributed by League Trolli or its partners.

6 ADDITIONAL TOURNAMENT RULES MAY APPLY:

Additional tournament-specific rules may apply at the discretion of the partnered Tournament Organizers operating each tournament under League Trolli. If additional rules apply to a specific tournament, they are included in such a way as to help ensure fairness and prevent exploits during gameplay.

Examples of tournament-specific rules include but are not limited to banned characters, banned stages or maps, banned weapons or items, etc.

Please note that tournament-specific rules will never conflict with the Master Terms & Conditions listed in this document.
