Step-by-step on how to register for classes:

- 1. Complete pre-registration in portal: Pre-registration Help Guide
- 2. Complete placement tests
 - a. You can opt-out of the English placement test if you have a 540 or higher on the SAT Reading and Writing section. You can opt-out of the Math placement test if you have a 530 or higher on the SAT Math section
 - b. The English test is proctored. You must go to your college's testing center to take the test. It has a 2 hour time limit and you can only take it once. You need to score a 6 or higher on the English placement test to be eligible to take the first college-level English requirement.
 - c. You can complete the Math test online through your portal. It is not a timed test, and you can retake it up to 4 times.. You need to score a 46 or higher on the <u>Math placement test</u> to be eligible for a college-level math requirement.
 - d. If you score below, you will be placed into a remedial course (not eligible for credit hours towards graduation requirements, below college-level, and will need to achieve a C or higher in that course to move on to your college-level course requirement.

3. Attend orientation

a. In your portal, in the bottom right corner, it should have information about your college's orientation.

4. Register for classes
