

#### Need help with prescription costs?

If you are uninsured, have health insurance that does not provide a prescription benefit, or have Medicare with no supplemental prescription drug coverage, you may benefit from prescription discount programs. There are several options available in Sedgwick County:

#### Medical Service Bureau Program Services

The Voucher Program: limited emergency financial assistance in the form of a voucher for the purchase of mainly generic prescription medications, diabetic supplies, prescription eyeglasses, and provides referrals for low-cost eye exams. We also assist the Medicare Part D beneficiaries with the prescription co-pays and/or purchasing their medications while they are in the "donut-hole".

The Pharmaceutical Drug Program (PDP): helps clients who qualify through guidelines established by the pharmaceutical companies to access brand name prescription medications for chronic illnesses for free or at a low-cost. The Medicare Part D Prescription Drug Program decreased the number of clients we served due to constant changes place by the Pharmaceutical Companies.

#### **Agency Requirements**

**Proof of Household Income**: Must be within the previous 30 days for each working member in the household. For those who have no income at all must have a referral letter from a community agency or health care provider. MSB has referral forms available, if needed please call.

**Proof of Identification:** Must bring documentation for every person living in the household. **Proof of Address:** Must bring something mailed in your name within the previous 30 days. **Proof of Insurance:** Must bring insurance card for everyone in the household if you have coverage.





#### Women, Infants and Children (WIC)

WIC is a temporary nutrition education and supplemental food program that provides assistance for women, infants and children. WIC provides:

- · Nutrition education to help improve you and your family's eating habits and health
- · Supplemental food checks to buy specific foods for good health
- · Referrals to community and health agencies for additional support
- · Free breastfeeding support and education classes!

To be eligible for the WIC program, women must meet income guidelines and be pregnant, breastfeeding or have recently delivered a baby. Children must be younger than five years of age. Program participants must receive a health exam by WIC staff and be found at medical and/or nutritional risk by a health professional.
