Thank you for your interest in the 9U SC Hype team!
(Players cannot turn 10 years old before May 1, 2027.)

We are excited to get this team started and hit the ground running! Below is some information about who we are and what families can expect for the upcoming season and beyond.

My name is Bryan Tucker, and I will be the head coach for this new team joining the existing SC Hype organization.

Travel baseball is an ever-evolving experience, but our goal is to provide every player and family with the best experience possible while helping the boys grow both on and off the field.

During each season, we will hold two (2) practices per week and plan to play approximately 3–4 tournaments during the Fall season and 4–6 tournaments during the Spring season. Attendance at practices and tournaments will be very important to the success of the team. We will do our best to avoid scheduling conflicts with school breaks and holidays whenever possible, although occasional overlaps may happen.

During the offseason, we plan to hold weekly training sessions to continue player development. Players are also encouraged to participate in outside lessons or training opportunities to help sharpen their individual skills.

If selected, every player will earn their position(s). No player will receive special treatment — including our own children. All players will learn multiple positions to help develop versatility and overall baseball IQ. Players will sit no more than two (2) innings per game unless illness, disciplinary action, or other circumstances arise. All players will bat.

Our philosophy will always be “team first.” We want to build a culture centered around hard work, accountability, and an “us over me” mentality.

Before officially joining the team, all players and parents will be asked to sign a player/parent agreement to ensure everyone is aligned regarding expectations, participation, and behavior.

We strongly encourage players to participate in other sports and activities. However, please understand that playing time and positions are earned not only during games, but also through practice attendance, effort, and commitment to the team. Our goal is not to discourage multi-sport athletes, but to build a successful and competitive team that grows together through consistent practice and development.

Team Dues:

\$500 per player, per season

(Fall and Spring seasons)

These dues will help cover uniforms, tournament fees, and practice field expenses. In the event of weather cancellations, we will attempt to hold indoor practices at 4C's Sports Lab or D-BAT, depending on availability.

The team will also participate in fundraising opportunities throughout the year. Funds raised may help offset future dues, purchase specialty uniforms, or allow the team to participate in larger tournaments.

All coaches and staff are volunteers and are not paid for their time.

Thank you again for your interest in SC Hype Baseball! We are excited to get started and build something special together.

The team will be selected once all interested players have completed a tryout. If you are unable to attend the June 20th tryout date, please let us know and we will do our best to arrange an alternate evaluation date.
