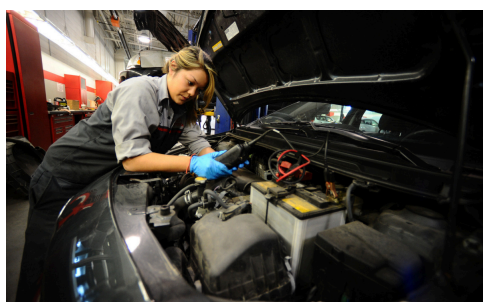


1. Read about the six people. How does each person introduce themselves?

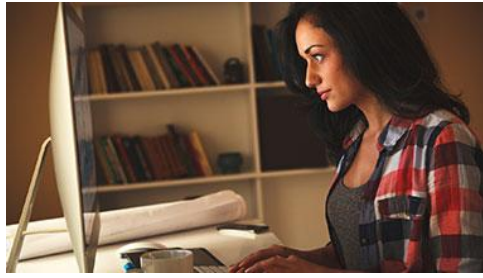

Hi, I'm Mathew. Nice to meet you. I really like visiting new places. That means I like traveling. I usually ride my motorcycle everywhere.



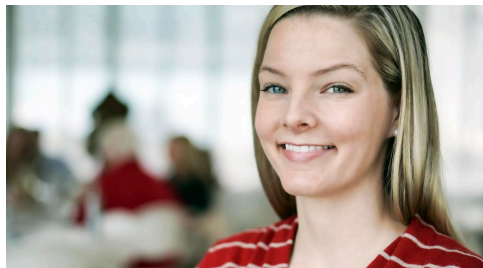
Hey, I'm Joanne. I'm a mechanic and a teacher. I teach automotive engineering at a university in my city. Are you interested in automobiles like me?
