

How do I get a copy of my QR code for vaccination proof?

- 1) Go to the [Ontario COVID-19 vaccination](#) site
- 2) You will need the following information ready to get your code:
 - 10 – digit health card number
 - 2 – letter version code
 - 9 – character code on the back of the card
 - Your date of birth
 - Your postal code
