Update: In light of recent experiences with donated bench being installed the policy for donations/trees/plaques/benches etc needs tweaking.

4. Agenda Items

4.1 Repair of main gate

The main outer wooden gate to the park has been damaged when the travellers arrived in the park recently. The council will replace it, possibly with a metal one similar to the existing inner gate. It was suggested bollards or a height restricter should be included but it needs to be removable to allow council vehicles and festival stall holders access. However these can still be bypassed or broken if the intention is there. Andrew to ask Sue (council) best option, impact, cost vs cost of clean up, etc

4.2 Memorial bench and trees

We have had 2 new benches donated. If more are donated we would have to ensure the cost of installation was included in the donation. Contractors for installing must be approved by the council and install to BCC standards.

One of the recently donated benches has caused some issues. the donor wanted hand prints and a locket and names in the cement base but while the cement was drying other graffiti was added. Louise tried to cover this up but it was quite a mess. Sue (council) is asking contractor to resurface the cement but danger of same thing happening again unless it is sat with while it dries.

4 trees are still pending until the right time of year for planting.

Feedback from Birmingham Open Spaces Conference.

The conference was led by Richard Link, the new Head of Parks, seconded for 2 years from the National Trust. He is an ex Architect and lives in Manchester. He wants to change the approach to funding of parks.
