

VOCABULARY NOTES (Unit 3)

blizzard - snowstorm

bomb- [bom] explode, go off

mb - [m] b- silent

comb, climb, lamb, bomb

cause (verb, noun) = reason

chase = follow, pursue, track

damage - noun, verb = hurt, ruin, destroy, harm

flood - verb, noun e.g.: The streets are flooded after a rainstorm.

human made disasters

force = power - noun

force - verb e.g.: My dog forced me to walk with me.

frightening - adjective = scary, terrifying

Frightened - adjective which describes feelings / emotions

air quality index - how good or bad the quality of air is.

harsh - strong (harsh wind), hot (harsh summer), cold (harsh winter), bad (harsh condition)

interrupt = cut in, butt in

rebuild - build again

re - prefix + root (word) -> do - redo, send - resend, write - rewrite

scream = shout, yell

BESIDE - next to, close, near Sit beside me.

BESIDES - in addition Yesterday was a busy day. I cleaned my house and besides that I cooked a great dinner.
