A Resolution Condemning Charlottesville Mayor, Nikuyah Walker's, Actions and Comments of March 24th, 2021

- WHEREAS: On March 24th, 2021, Charlottesville Mayor, Nikuyah Walker, tweeted and posted on Facebook an explicit post without any trigger warning of the mentioning of 'rape' for those who may be a victim of sexual assault (see Appendix A)¹; AND,
- WHEREAS: The UVA Student Council serves the Student Body in all of their best interests; THEREFORE BE IT,
- **RESOLVED:** The University of Virginia Student Council Representative Body condemns Nikuyah Walker's comment as it is not representative of how the Charlottesville community behaves and works together. Further, we condemn the comment as it did not contain a trigger warning, especially harmful for those who may be a victim of sexual assault.; **AND BE IT FURTHER,**
- **RESOLVED:** We call on Mayor Walker to release a written apology to the Charlottesville community, including the students of the University of Virginia.; **AND BE IT FURTHER**,
- **FINAL RESOLVED:** Mayor Walker shall receive a copy of this legislation immediately after it is passed.
