- **5:00pm:** Dinner Prep
- **6:00pm:** Dinner and Debrief
- **10:00pm:** Lights out

- **7:30AM:** Leave camp (bring pack lunch) and drive to main Smith Rock [parking area.](#)
- **9:00AM-3:30pm:** Climb all day (bring pack lunch).
