Training Ground Regulations

"CONCEIVED BY HUNTERS FOR HUNTERS"

- Effective March 1, 2023, full members have access to club grounds from March 1st through September 15th on Sunday through Saturday from sunrise to 9:00 p.m.
- Use driveway leading towards houses, then turn to the right before puppy pond, when pulling
 off Faussett road. Park north of puppy pond, west side of track. No parking at front pines or
 near houses.
- Members are requested to keep training activities away from the private residences and barn.
- There is a "restroom" for club members use located towards the back of the property at Hobo Camp.
- The MIHRC will not do any trimming or grooming of the south edge of the Puppy Pond, nor will there be any parking in the fields or driveway south of the Puppy Pond.
- Driving around grounds:
 - Vehicles access to travel along established property routes outside of mowed pastureland.
 - Stay on the two-track roads at all times. When grounds are wet or soaked (early spring & late fall), do not operate a vehicle beyond the club parking area.
 - No driving vehicles on south side of puppy pond.
 - If you make ruts or get stuck, please fix them.
- Smokers Do not discard butts on the grounds. Please take them with you.
- Tree and brush trimmings to be stacked and burned next to the west side of the middle pond outside of the mowed pastureland and established property route
- No glass containers permitted on grounds. Cans and plastic bottles MUST be removed.
- Children are the responsibility of their parents. All children of members are welcome, and we
 encourage family involvement. Members are responsible for their children's activities and
 behavior and are expected to always supervise them. Be aware that there are a lot of
 "hazards" including dogs, vehicle traffic, gravel, ponds, snakes, etc.
- GUN SAFETY WILL BE ENFORCED AT ALL TIMES. All hunting, testing, and training situations require ultimate gun safety.
- Nothing louder than primer loads are to be used for training. The use of "popper" loads is prohibited.
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted before or during any training, testing or work session on Club grounds.
- Bitches in heat are not permitted on the grounds.
- Dogs must be on lead except when working or in a designated exercise area.
- Aggressive dog behavior will not be tolerated. Keep your dog in control.
- Corrections to your retriever must be within reason. Treatment of a retriever beyond an acceptable correction will not be tolerated.
- All shell casings must be picked up and disposed of. Please pick up anything that is not "natural" to the property, such as trash, cans, wrappers, etc.

- Dead birds used in training must be removed from grounds and disposed of properly.
- Club Equipment is available for club members to use for training on the club grounds only. All
 equipment must be returned to and stored in the club trailer at the end of each training session.
 (Exceptions are the winger frames that may be temporarily left out in spring and summer for
 ease of training set-up). Report any equipment in need of repair to club Vice President or
 training leader. All winger rubber/pouches are stored inside trailer after each training session
 to prolong life and minimize wear.
- Club Guns are for use by members on the club grounds only. It's always a better idea to train
 with your own gun, but the club guns are available if needed. Check them out from a Board
 member. You must clean any gun used.
- Markers, tape, flags, posts, etc. must be removed after training for blinds or tracking tests.
 Anytime you see marker tape, please remove when training session is completed.
- Don't disturb other members training sessions. Please us common sense and courtesy.
- Young dogs are easily distracted by other dogs or bumpers at a distance.
- Be aware that consistent violations of the above could result in MIHRC Board Action. (in accordance with Article V, Section A, MIHRC By –Laws and Constitution)
