Kafrican Accords



This treaty is made with the agreement of all signatory parties.

Within this agreement the southern region shall be delineated as the *Nuut Dinsmark Government* as shall the northern region be delineated as the *Ambargo Government*. *Chikushinal* shall be delineated as such.

Article 1

The Nuut Dinsmark Government is to be integrated into existing Ambargo Government devolved systems. This combined government shall retain the State Emblems and Title of the Ambargo government.

Article 2

The official state language shall remain Kostel as too will the divisional status of the Nuut Dinsmark Government. Strelkan speaking areas shall be partitioned from those of a Kostel Majority. The official language in these areas is to be recognised as Strelkan.

Article 3

The Ambargo Government is to revoke their claim to the region of South Bal and Chikushinal, demarcated in red below. And to recognise the independence of the Local Government.



Article 4

Chikushinal shall make no claim to territorial regions within the area of south kafrica nor seek to pursue those claims.

Article 5

The port of South Post(Sopost) is to be leased to the Arcovi-Zokesian government for a period of five(5) years ending in 2157. On ending of this five(5) year period Sopost is to be handed to the Ambargo Government.

Article 6

Recognition of the provinces of Grestin and Pogo as an integral and inseparable component of the ambargo government by all parties not currently fulfilling this recognition.

Article 7

The Ambargo government is to fall under the military assistance of Arcovi-Zokesia during a fifteen(15) year period of integration from the Nuut Dinsmark Government.

Article 8

The Chikushinal government is to remain under the military assistance of Arcovi-Zokesia until such a time as the Arcovi-Zokesian government sees fit to withdraw or a period of twenty(20) years have passed from signing.
