A. YMCA COMPASS TAG Afterschool Program (Grades K-5)

This is a free program is designed to provide enriching experiences for our elementary school students beyond the regular school day. This program offers a variety of activities that promote academic support, leadership development, and creative exploration in a safe and supportive environment.

Program Details

- **Start date:** Monday, September 15
- **End date:** Friday, June 12
- **Hours of operation:** 2:20pm-5:30pm
- **Dismissal time:** 3:45pm (early dismissal) or 5:15pm-5:45pm *only*
- **Eligibility Requirements:** Participants must be in Elementary School at Talented and Gifted School for Young Scholars (TAG)
- **Description:** A free after-school program for elementary school students at TAG Young Scholars School in conjunction with the NYC Department of Youth and Community Development. Vanderbilt Y COMPASS @ TAG will operate Monday – Friday during the after-school hours. Y COMPASS is free, and enrollment is first come, first served starting in September. COMPASS will offer a variety of activities for elementary school students to join. Homework assistance will also be available for students in need of additional academic support
- **Application deadline:** Monday, September 1st

Participation in the program is free of charge and is available to all TAG Young Scholars Elementary School Students (Grades K-5)
