OSGeo Oceania Community Recognition Awards

Preamble

The OSGeo Oceania Community Recognition Awards are designed to showcase the amazing community we have in Oceania and to recognize those who have made a significant contribution to it and the work that they have produced.

Recognition

There are four types of recognition that are available, as follows:

- Diversity and Inclusion Champion of the Year: awarded to someone who has contributed to increasing the diversity and inclusion of our community or a related area.
- Community Member of the Year: awarded to someone who has made a significant contribution to the OSGeo Oceania community or in a related area
- Team of the Year: awarded to a group of people or an organisation who are part of, promoting or representing the OSGeo Oceania community in an outstanding way
- Product of the Year: awarded to an individual or a team for producing something that is outstanding. This could be a map, a software product, an open data product, an event or any other kind of work output.

Process

- Day 0: Call for nominations for each category is opened to the community
- Day 0-30: Nominations are sent privately to awards@foss4g-oceania.org
- Day 30: Valid nominations are listed on the OSGeo wiki
- Day 30-60: Open voting process
- Day X: Present FOSS4G SOTM Oceania Conference
- Update wiki page with results and celebrate

Recognition details

Community Member

Recognise an OSGeo Oceana community member's contribution to FOSS4G and/or Open Street Map. For example this could be a person who:

- · Created and /or led lead community events
- Active in the OSGeo Oceania organisation
- Active OSM mapper
- Active FOSS4G contributor.

Diversity and Inclusion Champion

Recognise someone who has been active in supporting diversity and inclusion initiatives across Oceania, specifically in the OpenStreetMap and FOSS4G domain.

- Criteria?
- Demonstrated leadership in promoting diversity, through implementing measures that promote representation from marginalised groups
- Demonstrated awareness-raising for diversity issues in the FOSS domain

Team

Recognise an organisation, a team or a group who are contributing to the community. For example, this might be a team that:

FAQ

Does the candidate need to be an OSGeo Oceania member?

• Not, not at all, but we do remind you that membership is free.

Does the candidate/entity need to be resident in Oceania?

 No, but we would expect a close affinity to Oceania, i.e., has worked in Oceania or on Oceania-based products. The contribution, service or product must be of interest to Oceania residents.

Does the product/service/map need to be completely created using FOSS or OSM?

We recognize that in some cases proprietary tools may need to be used, but we
would expect the majority of the product/service/map would utilise FOSS4G and/or
OSM/open data.
