What	MAP Growth tests are used to determine students' instructional level and to measure academic growth throughout the school year (and from year to year) in math and reading.
How	All tests are given using a computer.
Who	All students in grades 2, 3, 4, and 5.
When	The Reading MAP and Math MAP tests are given three times a year, in the Fall, Winter, and Spring.
Why	MAP Growth tests provide immediate and accurate information about your child's learning. It allows teachers to meet your child's needs and plan for effective personalized learning instruction.
