Exhibit: LISTEN. ACT. ADVOCATE. Protect victims. Serve communities.

What: A juried exhibit of up to 30 pieces of 2-dimensional art which depict this year's National Crime Victims' Rights Week theme of LISTEN. ACT. ADVOCATE. This is a call to action to support and advocate for all survivors and victims of crime.

Why art, you may be wondering. In December 2021, the Williamson County Attorney's Office became aware of a crime involving a 15 year old female victim. Very sadly, this young girl did end up succumbing to her injuries weeks later. Among many other things, the victim loved to draw and use her imagination to create art. Her art was a way for her to express herself with vibrant colors to a canvas.

Because of this, the Williamson County Attorney's Office decided that an art exhibit to go along with the annual ceremony is the perfect way to honor those whose lives have been lost as well as those who are survivors of violent crime. This gives artists the opportunity to connect with others through their art and provide a sense of hope, power, resilience, and support.

Artwork depicting any of these themes are acceptable for submission.

Location: The location of the exhibit is 100 Wilco Way, 2nd floor, Georgetown. This is where you will drop off and pick up your artwork.

Dates to remember:

Drop-off: Monday, April 20, 10am-12noon

Exhibit dates: April 21-22, 8am-5pm

Ceremony: Wednesday, April 22, 11am (you are welcome to attend if you wish)

Pick-up: Thursday, April 23, 10am-12noon

Criteria: The exhibit will be juried for 1) compositions that are suitable for the theme, and 2) space limitations. Jurors will be selecting WCAG member art that is family friendly, evocative, creative, unique, of high artistic quality, and has an overall impact consistent with the theme.

A maximum of 3 submissions is allowed, and all three may not be accepted to the exhibit. At this stage there is no size limitation; however, pieces may not be selected due to size depending on space limitations of the exhibit.
