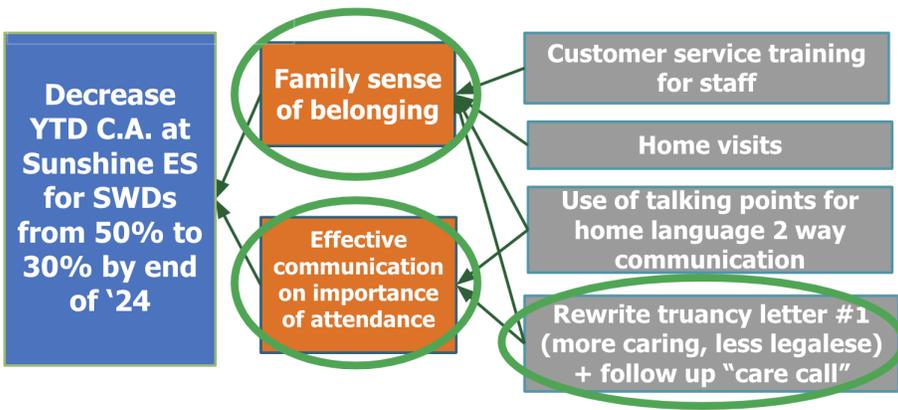


Improvement Project Charter - Chronic Absenteeism

Critical Questions	Success Criteria
<p>1. What is your specific and actionable problem of practice?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● A problem, without a solution already embedded ● Specific ● Actionable - within your control ● High leverage - You would make significant progress if you could solve this problem
<p>Students with disabilities (SWDs) have rates of chronic absenteeism that are disproportionately higher than other student groups, because the families of SWDs do not feel a sense of belonging at school and because of a lack of clear communication regarding attendance policies and the importance of attendance at school</p>	
<p>2. What is the team trying to accomplish? (Can include big dot and small dot aims)</p>	<p><u>SMART E Aim statement checklist:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● S - Specific (How much? for whom? Includes baseline data) ● M - Measurable (Provides ongoing formative, and summative data) ● A - Aspirational and Attainable (Big enough to matter, small enough to win) ● R - Relevant (Compelling to those who work on it) ● T - Timebound (Having a target for this school year) ● E - Equitable (Towards addressing injustice, inequity, or oppression)
<p>Decrease chronic absenteeism for SWDs at Sunshine Elementary in grades K-6 from 50% to 30% by May 2024.</p>	
<p>3. What changes might the team introduce and why? (Theory of improvement)</p>	<p>The change idea(s) chosen, need to be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Informed by research / evidence based best practices ● Logical - <i>If we try ..(change idea).. that will impact ..(driver) ..which in turn will lead to..(aim).</i> ● Quick and inexpensive to test ● Measurable
<p><i>IfWe rewrite truancy letters and follow up with a “care call”</i> <i>Then....we will increase effectiveness of communication and sense of belonging</i> <i>Which will lead to....a reduction in chronic absenteeism</i></p>	

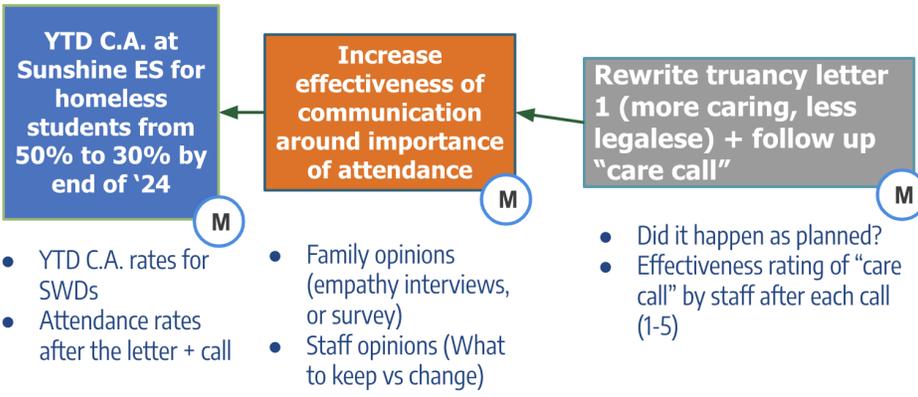
Driver Diagram



4. How will the team know if a change is an improvement?

Includes measures for:

1. *Change idea* (Should include an outcome measure, could include short term process measures)
2. *Driver*
3. *Aim measures* (Both big dot and small dot aims)



All of the measures above would be collected on a monthly basis. The first "study" session will occur at the end of September, 2 months after the start of school. The plan is to then continue cycles on a monthly basis.
