

Steps to export your Bitcoin Address/Private Key from Bitcoin Core and import into Omniwallet

1. Open your Bitcoin software.

2. Click on the menu **Help / Debug window** (at the top in the menu bar).

3. Click on the **Console** tab.

3a. If your wallet is encrypted, type the following command followed by the Enter key to unlock the wallet (for “mypasswordhere”, enter the password for your wallet, and 120 is the number of seconds the wallet will be unlocked):

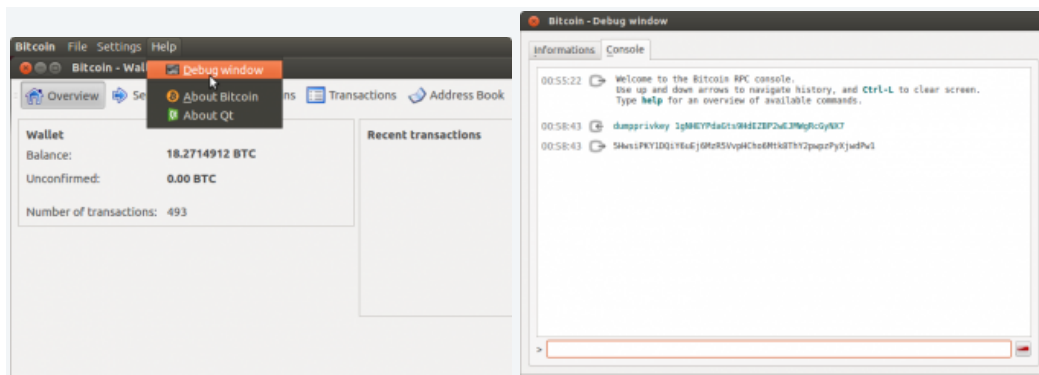
walletpassphrase mypasswordhere 120

4. Type the following command to export the key (for “mybitcoinaddresshere”, please enter the Bitcoin address for which you wish to retrieve the private key):

dumpprivkey mybitcoinaddresshere

The private key is shown on the screen. It is a long string of characters starting with the number 5.

5. Copy your private key to the clipboard (Ctrl-C/Cmd-C)

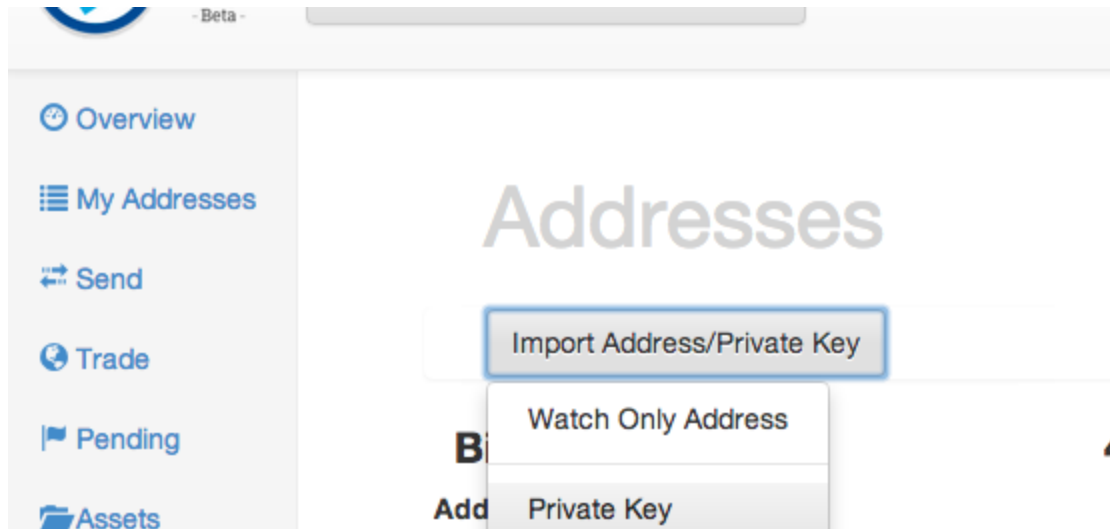


6. Go to <http://www.omniwallet.org>

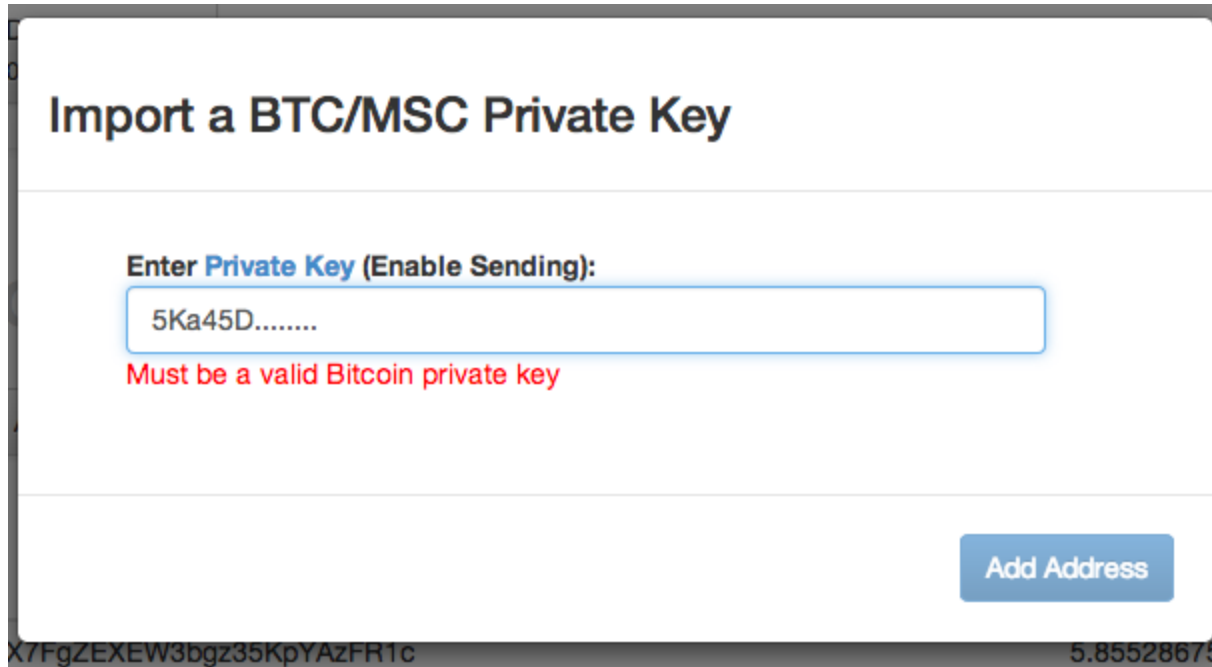
7. If you do not already have a wallet on Omniwallet click '**Create wallet**', or log into your existing wallet if you already have one on Omniwallet.

8. **Remember to save your wallet link after logging in!**

9. Click **'My Addresses'** from the left sidebar and then click the button labeled **'Import Address/Private Key'** and then choose **'Private Key'** (you are *not* importing a watch-only address)



10. Paste your private key into the given field (Ctrl-V/Cmd-V) and click the **'Add Address'** button



11. ***Remember to backup your wallet *as soon as you add a private key****

12. Your imported Bitcoin Address will now be available in Omniwallet under **"My Addresses"**
