## **Binder Project Ideas**

I'm always being asked to come up with more binder projects for the woodshop so here is your chance to help me do that very thing. Remember, I don't have an unlimited budget for wood so be sensitive to the cost by creating a Materials List and an estimated cost for each project.

## **REQUIREMENTS** - See Rubric.

- 1. Create Binder Project in Google Slides.
- 2. Use an appropriate theme/background for the project, but make sure that all text is easy to read and not too color heavy or you'll use up my colored ink when I print to put in binders...see my samples below.
- 3. Take your own pictures (email them to yourself and put in Google Drive).
- 4. Title slide needs to include the name of the Project, most recent revision date, your name, and the estimated skill level (beginner, intermediate, advanced). Here are a few samples of my current binder projects: <a href="Beginner">Beginner</a>, <a href="Intermediate">Intermediate</a>, <a href="Advanced">Advanced</a>
- 5. Steps must be numbered.
- 6. No more than 16 slides please (title and QR code slides don't count against you)
- 7. Binder projects may not cost more than \$100 to make (Ideal Budget: Level 1 = \$20, Level 2 = \$30, and Level 3 = \$50).
- 8. May include short video clips as URL's. Use tinyurl.com to create a shorter URL for posting in your slideshow.
