A note from Mrs. Geatley:

It is extremely important that your child complete their weekly work. I have started keeping students in from their first recess if their classwork is not completed. Every week they have spelling words that are stapled into their assignment books. They are also found in Google Spelling 5 classroom. Each week there is a worksheet or an activity.

In reading we are reading the novel, <u>Number the Stars</u>. There will be a test over the whole book, so make sure to check your child's assignment book regularly. I anticipate that it will occur the second week of March.

We are starting Biztown lessons and our field trip is March 15.

I have noticed a decline in grades in both reading and spelling. Please use Spelling City to help your child prepare for spelling tests.

I am also concerned about the talking and the lack of focus in class. Please discuss this with your child so it can be corrected before I need to hand behavioral notices out.
