We are interested in your thoughts about home learning to decide whether we will continue this in 2018. Previously, the expectation has been that children in the Hillary Team (from year 4-8) will do 30 minutes home learning Monday-Thursday.

We could instead choose to have different home learning requirements for each year level or we could choose to have an 'opt in' home learning programme where parents choose whether or not their children would take part.

There is no evidence that homework has any academic benefit for primary and intermediate children, but we are also aware that many believe home learning has the potential to help develop good habits for future study.
