## **German Kaiser abdicates criticises the current government US-Austrian Alliance?**

**Germany, 17th of September**

Only a day after the Mannheim conference crisis, the German Kaiser abdicated. According to some sources, after a recall process was started.

He had issued the following statement announcing his abdication:

“I announce my immediate abdication and leave the crown to my heir Vicotaco. May he and his reign live long. May be people of Germany prosper under his rule. And may the enemies of Germany tremble under the mighty power of our panzers.”

We at the Global sat down with him to let him tell his side of the story.

**Interviewer (In):** So why did you abdicate?

**Former Kaiser RB33 (RB):** My own people had turned against me in a hysterical outcry for mishandling Austrian diplomacy. A recall process was called upon me by my own Reichskanzler Vico. With little support and constant calls of being a traitor. I decided to end it before waiting out the recall vote.

**In:** Why were you called a traitor?

**RB:** I honestly don't know, not toeing the Pro-Austrian line enough, I guess.

**In:** So do you admit to having committed errors during the Mannheim negotiations?

**RB:** No, it was worthless to say those things and take such a hard stance, but I think that Germany should have the right to act as it wishes, if it feels that if it's in the interest of European peace and stability. Allowing Austria to fall to foreign annexation is something I deemed unacceptable. That the Austrian Foreign Minister later admitted to that they would've accepted our help regardless and had just made a mess for the sake of making a moral argument was just very disappointing.

**In:** Now that you have moved into exile in Holland, do you have any interest in German or world politics?

**RB:** Germany, as I would've have expected after I abdicated is in a bit of a mess now. Vico, even if not fully trustworthy is probably the most competent leader in Germany right now. Appointing Bowie as his Reichskanzler and Revan as Foreign Minister was questionable. But to be honest, it's not like he has much choice, since the active Germans are few in number. The Germany we are going to see now is not the
