The M5 "Setup" is the backend of your Mandarin catalog; it is not related to your library data, like patrons or bibliographic records. It is used to make changes to the interface of your current Library catalog website (not to your records). The default login is "admin" and the password is "boca raton". We recommend not changing it.
